

ACCESS AND CAR PARKING CHANGES TO ALBERT ROAD (SOUTHERN LEG) APRIL TO NOVEMBER 2017

Works in preparation for major construction of the Metro Tunnel are continuing in the Domain precinct with the relocation of utility services underway and service investigations continuing ahead of upcoming works.

Early Works in the Domain precinct will include the relocation of the South Yarra Main Sewer beneath the proposed footprint for the future Domain Station. Due to the age and condition of the existing sewer, a new, reinforced sewer will be constructed adjacent to the existing service.

These works will require changes to traffic conditions and public car parking availability.

Construction timeframes

It is estimated that the relocation of the South Yarra Main Sewer, including site preparation works in Albert Road (southern leg), will take approximately seven months. The timing of construction activities is indicative and subject to change.

Albert Road access and parking changes

- The southern leg of Albert Road from St Kilda Road (with local access to be maintained to 1 Albert Road, South Melbourne) will remain closed for the duration of these works
- Access to the Kings Way end of the southern leg of Albert Road is only possible via the northern leg of Albert Road from St Kilda Road.

Car parking

- 89 car parking spaces will be removed to facilitate the works and site establishment activities.

Accessibility car parking

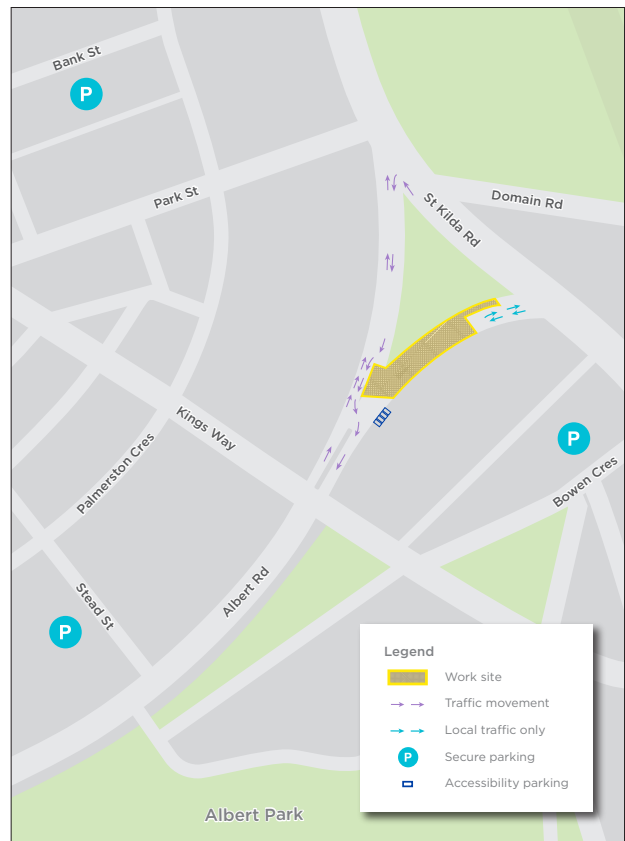
- Four DDA compliant car parking spaces have been relocated adjacent to the kerb just south of the Albert Road Clinic (see map).

Alternative car parking in the area

- There will be limited on-street car parking still available on the northern leg of Albert Road and on St Kilda Road
- A number of carparks in the area offer short-term paid parking as shown in the map.
